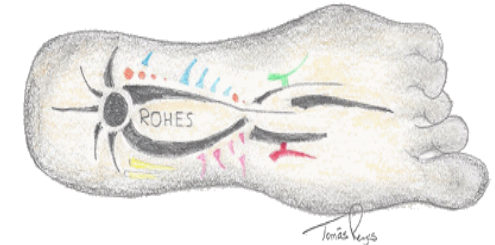

The core Reflexology course of study will meet on weekends Therapeutic Reflexology A Step-by-Step Guide to Professional Competence by Paula S. Stone, MA, NCTMB, LMT, CMR, CRL, ARCB-CR will be the main textbook to be used in this course.

Additional courses will also be part of the core teaching—**Business 101 and Beyond for Natural Healers, KHT, Microsystems for Enhanced Clinical Results, Gemstone Reflexology, Facial Reflexology, Module 1, and TCM & Neuro Foot Reflexology** by Lila M. Mueller, CRR, ART (Regd), NBCR; **Energy/Vibration Healing Ways of the Ancients, Essential Oils and Stones for Healing** by Jean Reddemann.

The classes will meet monthly on Saturday and Sunday for the duration of course of study. Winter and fall months will meet more frequently on week-ends to ensure completion of the material needed to complete this course of study.

A Diploma will be given out to students who have successfully completed the core course of study with a minimum of 300 hours. CEU's may be available for classes outside of the core course of study.

Additional tutoring will be available to students who have attained a Diploma towards studying for their Reflexology National Board Exams.

Student Membership Fee for the IRW (Integrated Reflexologists of WI, Inc.) will be provided for one (1) year to all students who successfully complete the core curriculum.
